THE SESSION'S MESSAGE

Confession and prayer. Owning up to the sins that I have committed and pleading for forgiveness.

When I opened my Bible, I found myself in the Book of Daniel chapter 9. This was a prayer that Daniel prayed to God on behalf of himself and the nation of Israel.

Daniel 9:3-4 says,

3 Then I turned my face to the Lord God, seeking him by prayer and pleas for mercy with fasting and sackcloth and ashes. 4 I prayed to the LORD my God and made confession, saying, "O Lord, the great and awesome God, who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments,

Daniel humbled himself before the Lord and acknowledged who God was - the great and awesome God. In the next several verses we see Daniel change his pronoun from "I" to "we" and is paraphrased:

We have done wrong and have acted wickedly. We didn't listen to your prophets. You, O Lord, are righteous and holy. But we deserve shame. All are guilty of sinning against you. No one is exempt, not our kings nor our princes nor our fathers.

So, we cannot exclude our own sinfulness by blaming our rulers. We have God's word and from that word we know what is right and what is wrong.

We know that all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God. How do we make it right? In order to get out of the hole that we are in, we must first stop digging. Then, we turn from our sin and acknowledge that God is our only salvation. Without God we can do nothing but with God all things are possible.

Hold fast to the Word of God. Do not let yourself be swayed by the current culture. The current culture will lead you down a path of destruction. Daniel held fast to the Word of God, and his prayer was answered. Daniel 9:21-23 says,

21 while I was speaking in prayer, the man Gabriel, whom I had seen in the vision at the first, came to me in swift flight at the time of the evening sacrifice. 22 He made me understand, speaking with me and saying, "O Daniel, I have now come out to give you insight and understanding. 23 At the beginning of your pleas for mercy a word went out, and I have come to tell it to you, for you are greatly loved. Therefore, consider the word and understand the vision.




