THE PASTOR'S MESSAGE

And be thankful. (Colossians 3:15b ESV)

November 2022 is both the month of the midterm elections this year and the month of our yearly celebration of the Thanksgiving holiday. I hope that all who read this newsletter vote on November 8 and do so from Christian convictions. And whatever the outcome, God remains our Provider, Protector, and Preparer (see Psalm 23). Let's be reminded this month: one of the primary Christian virtues is thankfulness, or gratitude. I recently noticed how often *thanksgiving* is mentioned in Paul's letter to the Colossians. It is mentioned no less than seven times.

1:3 We always <u>give thanks</u> to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ when we pray for you.

1:11-12 (Paul prays for them that) being strengthened with all power, according to his glorious might, for all endurance and patience with joy; <u>giving thanks</u> to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in light.

2:6-7 Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him, rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, <u>abounding in</u> thanksgiving.

3:15 And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. And <u>be</u> thankful.

3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, <u>with thankfulness</u> in your hearts to God.

3:17 And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, <u>giving thanks</u> to God the Father through him.

4:2 Continue steadfastly in prayer, being watchful in it with thanksgiving.

In one short letter we see a tapestry of gratitude. Paul is reminding us, at the very least, that we are thankful for friends, for brothers and sisters in Christ, for salvation in Christ, for life, for God's provision of our needs, for fellowship, and for an opportunity to work and rest. *Thank you, Lord, for all these things!*

James, our Lord's brother, tells us that every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights (see James 1:17). Paul, on the other hand, tells of the dangers of ingratitude. In a lengthy exposition of the sinfulness of humanity, he writes, *For although they knew God, they did not honor him as God or give thanks to him, but they became futile in their thinking, and their foolish hearts were darkened* (Rom. 1:21). As you meditate on the verses listed above, ask yourself, "Am I thankful today?"

Dear LORD, the Bible tells us that you are a Good Shepherd who knows his sheep and who provides for our physical, material, emotional, and spiritual needs. Thank you and please help us to be thankful. In Jesus' name, Amen.


