And I think that over time it even helps provide the needed environment for the truly sorrowful faces we encounter in our daily lives. If you need a little help finding a smile, you can turn to the happy occasion of Nehemiah 8. The reading of the law was bringing tears of weeping to the eyes of God's restored exiles. However Nehemiah kindly reminded them (and now us), Do not be grieved, for the joy of the LORD is your strength (8:10).






